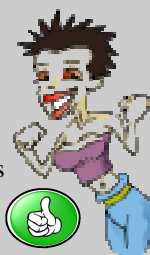
Another strong win by the Threes as they continued to plough through the opposition so far this season as they continue to hold fast to first place.

Rebound Discs

This gives you the freedom to be able to practice the shot that you are trying to perfect repeatedly, and with the aid of the Rebound Discs your development and achievement of your goal will be rapid."

The above is from the inventor of rebound discs & we recently received some literature on the subject, which was handed over to head coach Ron Suckling. He and the other coaches in consultation with the Bowls Committee will assess this method and if viable will put forward a proposal.

Norm & Hazel are advised to keep their curtains drawn at night, although with Normie any, would be photographer, would prefer it that way!

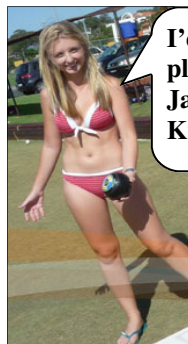

Coaching Sessions

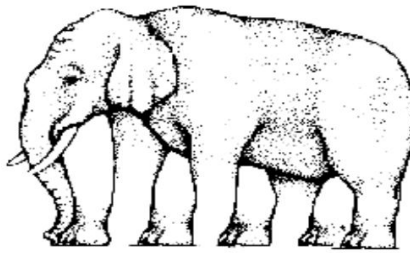
Ron Suckling & Mike Pursell has a regular coaching session held every Monday at 4.00 PM after the Cadburys Fours.

"Giddy up."

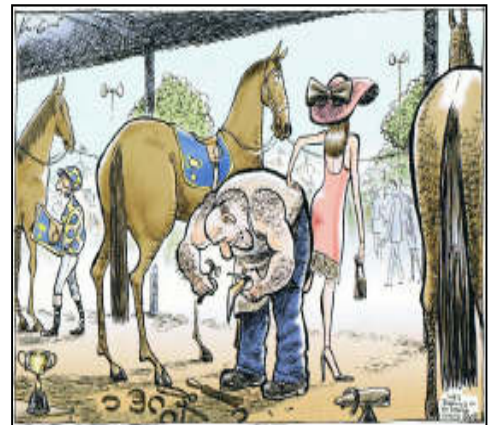
