The main speakers were David Bliss, President of the CGC & David Gillies, Architect from Bullock Consultants. David Gillies gave some background to the project to date, which has been developing over the past 18 months. He explained that despite talks with the GCC, they wanted a plan submitted. This went to Council on Thursday 17/2/2011. He went to great pains to state that all that this submission seeks to do is to have the prescribed area of land, including the Bowls club land, rezoned so that this project could proceed. The Bowls club has been invited to join with the Golf club to form one entity and together move through to the completion of this potentially superb sporting complex

David Gillies then presented the drawings of how the complex may look from the outside and gave assurances that changes could be made as time goes by & a vote will be taken later when the whole proposal is clear.

The assembly was given the opportunity to ask questions and make comments and on the whole these were very constructive and food for thought for our board and the three members who will work closely with the Golf Club. Members are invited to put on paper their thoughts about how the bowls side of the venture could best be served.

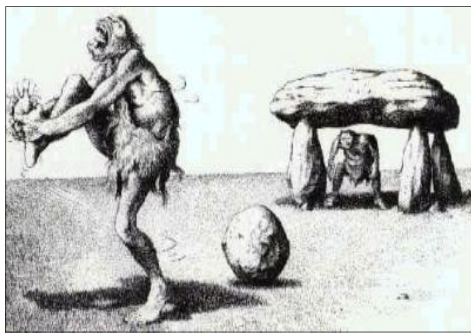
You will all be kept up to date on progress.

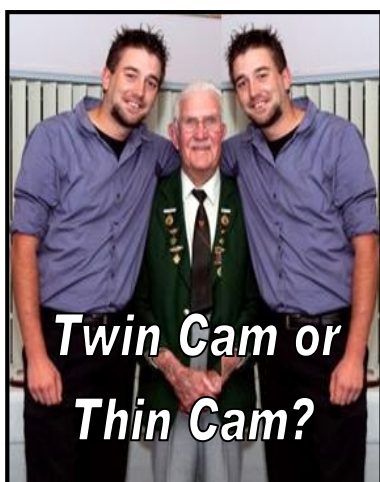

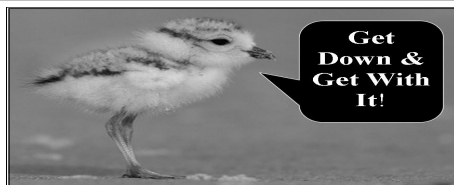

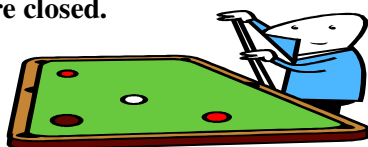
