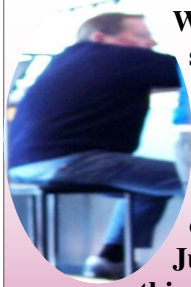

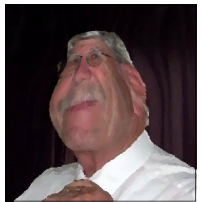

Gail called excitedly, "I nearly had a stroke!"

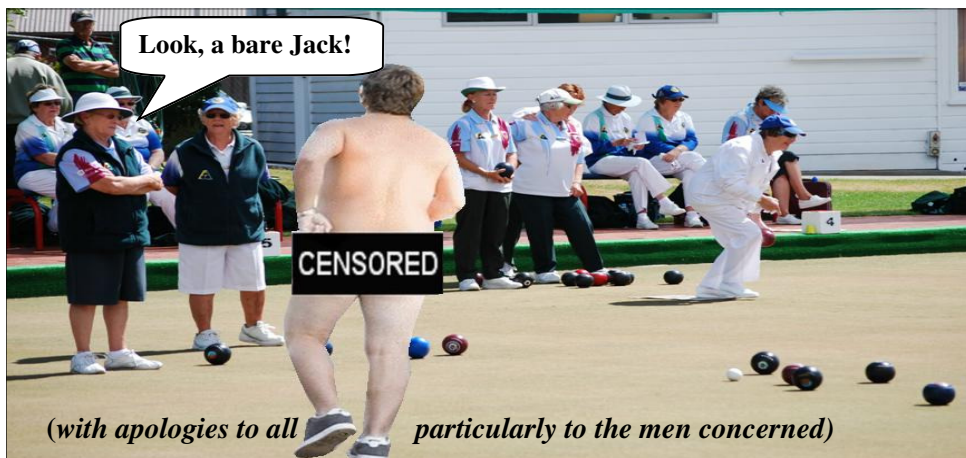
Kathleen took a piece of chalk, and chased him down the track,

Q and A

You ask 'em & we'll Answer 'em!
(Sometime the answer to questions are not always what we have been used to and here is one)

Q. In a club Championship pairs game, a skip refuses to put the scores up on the scoreboard. Is this sanction by the laws of the game?

A. No. A scorecard should be kept and completed by the seconds of each team. If there is no scoreboard attendant available, the seconds between them should update the scoreboard at least every second end. D.R.3.3.1
